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COURSE CURRICULUM

1. Verb forms Used in Daily Life

- Knowing the exact meaning of each verb.
- Understanding the correct use of the 2 different forms of verbs.
- Learning the proper spellings of verbs in the 1st form as well as the 2nd form.
- Practicing the correct pronunciation of both forms of every verb used in daily life.

2. Pronouns and their different forms used in daily life

- Knowing the 7 pronouns used in place of nouns in English.
- Understanding the 4 different forms of each pronoun in English.
- Practicing the Subject form and Object form of each pronoun in various sentences.
- Learning the use of the possessive adjective and possessive pronoun forms.

3. Structures while framing sentences in various tenses

- Knowing the structure of positive statements in different tenses.
- Understanding the structure of negative statements in various tenses.
- Learning the structure of positive interrogative statements.
- Practicing the framing of negative interrogative statements.

4. 12 Tenses in the “Active Voice” used 95% of the time in daily life

- Understanding Tenses and the difference between Simple Tenses and Perfect Tenses.
- Learning to frame sentences with verbs as well as without verbs in all tenses.
- Knowing how to use the right tenses as per the demand of the situation.
- Practicing the framing of all 4 forms of statements in each of the 12 Tenses.

5. Question Words used in English and their meanings in Hindi

- Knowing all the Question words used in English with their meanings in Hindi.
- Learning the correct use as well as pronunciations of all the Question Words.
- Understanding that all the question words are also used as conjunctions in English.
- Practicing framing questions with and without the use of Question Words.

6. Introduction to 21 helping verbs used to frame questions in the English language

- Learning the use and meaning of each and every helping verb in English;
- Knowing the fact that 95% Questions cannot be asked without the help of helping verbs;
- Understanding the importance of helping verbs in framing Negative Statements;
- Practicing the use of helping verbs in negative as well as interrogative statements.

7. When and How to use “There is” / “There are” / “There was” / “There were” etc.

- Knowing when exactly to use the above form of sentences in English;
- Learning the application of the above, especially when there is no verb in the sentence.
- Understanding that “There” used here is just a supporting word and doesn’t mean “there”.
- Practicing framing sentences with the above in positive, negative and question forms.

8. Different uses of Have/Has/Had

- Learning to use the above words as verbs for Possession/Consumption/Compulsion.
- Knowing the use of the above as verbs other than the above 3 uses in English.
- Understanding the use of the above words as helping verbs in Perfect Tenses.
- Practicing the multiple uses of the above words in different types of tenses.

9. The use of articles (“a”, “an” and “the”) in the English language

- Understanding the proper use of these words in English;
- Knowing that the use of these words is only related to Nouns;
- Learning the role of vowels while using these words;
- Consciously practice the use of these words while framing sentences.

10. The use and placing of Prepositions while conversing in the English language

- Knowing at least around 30 prepositions used in English in daily life;
- Understanding the importance of the use of some of these words in English;
- Learning that prepositions are placed before the words they are related to, unlike Hindi.
- Practicing the proper use of basic prepositions in the smallest of sentences.

11. The use of 10 different prepositions in place of the preposition "SE" in Hindi

- Knowing that there are at least 10 different prepositions in English used in place of "SE";
- Learning the use of the correct preposition in every situation in place of the word "SE";
- Understanding that none of these prepositions can be used in place of each other;
- Practicing the proper use of these prepositions as per the demand of the situation.

12. Degrees of Comparison in small as well as big Adjectives

- Knowing the meaning of at least 30 adjectives in English, used in daily life;
- Understanding the 3 different degrees of comparison in adjectives;
- Learning the difference in style used for comparison for small adjectives and big adjectives.
- Practicing the pattern of framing sentences in negative comparisons;
